







This memorandum refers to the removal of eight underground storage tank on June 1, 1993 at the Black Mesa Mine, located near Shiprock, NM, on land of the Navajo Nation .

Based on our file review and discussions held at the San Francisco meeting on December 17, 2007 with the Navajo Nation EPA (NNEPA), this site does not appear to pose a current threat to human health and the environment. Therefore, EPA Region IX and the NNEPA are not requiring further action at this site.
