This correspondence refers to the underground storage tank (UST removal report, dated July 5, 2006, that was prepared by Zelen Environmental for the Junction Chevron Station (now Exxon), located in Cameron, AZ on land of the Navajo Nation.

The analytical results for soil samples collected at this site on October26, 2006 indicate no hydrocarbon concentrations above appropriate EPA, Region IX or Navajo Nation EPA (NNEPA) soil cleanup levels. The information submitted has assisted EPA and NNEPA in assessing the status of this site, where three USTs were removed on June 20, 2006. Based on this data, this site does not appear to pose a current threat to human health and the environment. Therefore, EPA and NNEPA are not requiring further action at this time.
