RE: No Further Action on NAV# 220 Eli Williams Steamboat, Arizona

Dear Mr. Warren:

Enclosed is the tank pull report for Eli Williams dated September 13, 2004. Navajo EPA had contracted with Ironhorse Environmental Services to obtain soil samples from the former tank nest and the pump dispenser island. Mr. Eli Williams, Jr., son of former owner, indicated that 3 underground storage tanks (UST) were removed (date unknown). No USTs were found, but soil samples were obtained in the former tank nest area and under the pump dispensers.

I have reviewed the report and found that all analytical results (pit and dispenser, #1, #2, and #3) for soil samples collected at the former UST site on May 26, 2004, indicate no hydrocarbon concentrations above appropriate EPA, Region IX or Navajo Nation EPA soil cleanup levels. Therefore, NNEPA Leaking UST Program Office is not requiring further action at this time.

However, Navajo EPA Executive Director, will issue a finalized "no further action" letter to the appropriate chapters and Navajo Economic Development office.
