This correspondence refers to the "Removal & Remediation Report" dated August 2001, that was prepared by Envirotech, Inc. for the removal of three underground storage tanks (USTs) at Diné College, located in Tsaile, Arizona, on land of the Navajo Nation.

Our review of the closure documents and analytical results for soil samples collected at the UST site indicates no hydrocarbon concentrations above appropriate EPA, Region IX or tribal soil cleanup levels.

The information submitted has assisted EPA in assessing the status of this site which does not appear to pose a current threat to human health and the environment. Therefore, EPA is not requiring further action at this time.

If new USTs are installed at the site, Tank Notification Form #7530-1 must be completed and sent to this office and the Navajo Nation EPA within 30 days after startup of the new UST system.
