This correspondence refers to the tank removal report dated June 14, 1997, that was prepared by iina ba for the removal of one underground storage tank (UST) at the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) Chinle Branch of Roads Maintenance Yard.

Our review of the closure documents and analytical results for soil samples collected at the UST site indicates no hydrocarbon concentrations above appropriate EPA, Region IX or Navajo Nation EPA soil cleanup levels.

The information submitted has assisted EPA in assessing the status of this site, where one UST was removed on May 14, 1997. This site does not appear to pose a current threat to human health and the environment. Therefore, EPA is not requiring further action at this time.
