This correspondence refers to the closure report dated May 30, 2000, prepared by the IT Corporation for the Old Farm Area, located near the intersection of Fort Loop Road and Bah-Hon Nah Road, on land of the Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation.

Our review of the closure documents and analytical results for soil samples collected at the UST site indicates no hydrocarbon concentrations above Arizona State soil cleanup levels, which the tribal environmental department has adopted for this site.

The information submitted has assisted EPA in assessing the status of this site, where two underground storage tanks (USTs) were removed on April 28, 2000. This site does not appear to pose a current threat to human health and the environment. Therefore, EPA is not requiring further action at this time.
