Dear Mr. Wood:

EPA acknowledges the receipt of your correspondence and attached documentation regarding the disposition of the 10000 gal UST which was removed from the BIA Road yard on 08/27/1992. This facility is located on lands of the Gila River Indian Community.

The Tank Removal Report prepared by Burge & Associates indicates that the analytical results of soil samples taken in the tank pit show that no significant contamination exists and all sample results are well below action levels.

The UST was properly disposed of by Wright's Excavating Inc.

The information submitted previously has assisted EPA in assessing the status of this site. This site does not currently pose a threat to human health and the environment. EPA does not require further action at this time.
