EPA is in receipt of additional information regarding the underground storage tank (UST) removals and installation at the Navajo Nation Motor Pool. EPA requested an UST notification form be submitted for the new USTs installed at the site in a March 15, 1991 letter, in addition to information on the final disposal of the old USTs which were removed.

EPA has received the UST notification form for the newly installed tanks and details on the proper disposal of the old USTs which were removed. This site does not appear to currently pose a threat to human health and the environment. EPA is not requesting any further action at this time.

This correspondence is in regard to a recent file review of information available on the underground storage tank (UST) removal and installation at the Navajo Tribal Motor Pool, Window Rock, Arizona.


The manner in which the site assessment report prepared by Rocky Mountain Petroleum dated June 6, 1990 is presented makes interpretation of the work performed very difficult. A more thorough presentation using grammatical descriptions of the step by step process of the tank removal and sampling would expedite the review process.

We are requesting an UST notification form (included) be submitted for the new UST's installed per 40 CFR § 280.22. In addition, the site assessment report was found to lack information on the final disposal of the removed tanks. Please provide this information.

After reviewing information in the site assessment report, it appears the levels of contamination are very low. The highest reported concentration was 13 ppm of total petroleum hydrocarbons. This site does not appear to pose a threat to human health and the environment.

The completed notification form and any additional response presented to the EPA regarding this case should be submitted within 60 days of the date of this letter.
