Dear Mr. Barton:

EPA acknowledges receipt of the analytical results for soil samples collected during the removal of one underground storage tank (UST) at the Fleet Management Satellite in Shiprock, New Mexico, on land of the Navajo Nation.

Our review of the closure documents and analytical results for soil samples collected at the UST site indicates no hydrocarbon concentrations above appropriate EPA, Region IX or Navajo Nation EPA (NNEPA) soil cleanup levels.

The information submitted has assisted EPA and NNEPA in assessing the status of this site, where one UST used for the storage of waste oil was removed on November 30, 1998. This site does not appear to pose a current threat to human health and the environment. Therefore, EPA and NNEPA are not requiring further action at this time.
