This correspondence refers to the tank removal report dated January 1999, that was prepared by Leedshill-Herkenhoff, Inc. for the Tsegie Trading Post in Tsegie, Arizona, on land of the Navajo Nation.

The analytical results for soil samples collected at this site indicates no hydrocarbon concentrations above appropriate EPA, Region IX or Navajo Nation EPA (NNEPA) soil cleanup levels. The information submitted has assisted EPA and NNEPA in assessing the status of this site, where three underground storage tanks were removed on October27, 1998. Based on this data, this site does not appear to pose a current threat to human health and the environment. Therefore, EPA and NNEPA are not requiring further action at this time.
