The Environmental Protection Agency has carried out a file review of the Mario's Bingo site located on lands of the Yavapai- Prescott Indian Tribe. Two Underground Storage Tanks (UST's) were removed from this site on December 22, 1992. These tanks were stored in a remote location on tribal land until April 16, 1993. At that time the tanks were transported to the R & K Yard in Kingman, AZ and cut up for scrap.

The information submitted **previously** has assisted EPA in assessing the status of this site. It does not appear to currently pose a threat to human health and the environment. **No further action is required by EPA at this time.**
