Dear Mr. Manakaga:

This correspondence refers to the Supai Helicopter Landing Pad in Supai, Arizona where a underground storage tank (UST) was removed in July 27, 1989. Soil contamination was discovered during tank removal. The contaminated soil was backfilled into the excavation, but later re-excavated and aerated for several years. No samples were taken prior to disposing the soil on tribal lands.

Based on our review of the existing information and the telephone conference with W. Guggenheimer, this site does not appear to currently pose a threat to human health and the environment. Therefore, EPA is not requiring further action at this time.
