This correspondence refers to the Western Truck and Auto Repair facility at the San Xavier Industrial Park. On June 27,1995, two 5,000-gallon underground storage tanks (USTs) were removed at this site, which is located at the southern outskirts of Tucson, Arizona, on land of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.

A total of 115 cubic yards of diesel-contaminated soil was excavated from the tank pit. This soil was stockpiled at the site and decontaminated by landfarming. The soil was subsequently disposed. This information was confirmed by Jerry Williams of the Tohono O'Odham Environmental Program Office.

The information obtained has assisted EPA in assessing the status of this site, where two USTs were removed in June 1995. This site does not appear to pose a current threat to human health and the environment. Therefore, EPA is not requiring further action at this time.
