This correspondence refers to the underground storage tank (UST) removal report dated February 22, 2000, that was prepared by the VERDE Company for the Game and Fish Headquarters of the White Mountain Apache Tribe. Hydrocarbon-impacted soil encountered during the removal of four underground storage tanks (USTs) was bioremediated and disposed in the Tribal landfill. Based on a telephone communication between you and Walter Guggenheimer of my staff on December 10, 2003, the analytical results for samples collected prior to landfill disposal indicated no hydrocarbon concentrations above EPA or Tribal action levels.

The information submitted has assisted EPA in assessing the status of this site, where two USTs were removed on January 19, 2000. Based on this data, this site does not appear to pose a current threat to human health and the environment. Therefore, EPA is not requiring further action at this time.
