Duar Mr. Todakonzie:

The Environmental Protection Agency has received the Site Assessment Report for NTUA's District Office in Shiprock, NM located on lands of the Navaja Nation.

The report, prepared by Leedshill-Herkenhoff Inc. dated December 1993, indicates that Petroleum contamination encountered during the Underground Storage Tank(UST) removal during the week of September 14, 1992, was below action levels, both for soil and groundwater. These finding were based on ten soil borings and three groundwater monitoring wells, all of which were periodically sampled to obtain smallytical laboratory results.

The information submitted in the December 1993 report has assisted EPA in assessing the status of this site. It does not appear to currently pose a threat to human health and the environment. No further action is required by EPA at this time,
