The Environmental Protection Agency received your letter dated December 19, 1994 regarding the ultimate disposition of the 1000 gallon capacity waste oil tank which was removed from the Calmat site, located at 1900 Longmore Avenue, Mesa, AZ on land of the Salt River Pima- Maricopa Indian Community.

The reuse of this tank as an Above Ground Storage Tank for motor oil does not violate the EPA regulations in 40 CFR §280.72 or the recommended practices detailed in API's document # 1604.

The information submitted **above** has assisted EPA in assessing the status of this site. It does not appear to currently pose a threat to human health and the environment. **EPA does not require further action at this time.**
